Creating Space for Spirituality: Getting In Touch with Our Personal Spirituality as Music Therapists is approved by the Certification Board for Music Therapists (CBMT) for 5 Continuing Music Therapy Education credits. Course Description:

It is impossible to deny the impact that music has on the spiritual lives of a music therapist's patients, clients, and their families; it connects them with memories that feed their spirit and hope to cultivate meaning in the moment. This is a powerful component of a music therapist's work and so it is important that they too are mindful of their own spirituality in their professional and personal lives. In our time together, participants will explore ways that they are already expressing their spirituality and discover new ways that will benefit them as well as those they provide care to. We will discuss living our code of ethics as music therapists in mindful and meaningful ways. And we will begin to find ways to get comfortable with acknowledging our own dying and death as a way to help us journey with others who are dying.

Learner Objectives:

- 1) Participants will learn ways to make use of their own spiritual life and practices in order to provide meaningful care to their patients.
- 2) Participants will connect their own spiritual life with the code of ethics for music therapists.
- 3) Participants will explore their own thoughts and feelings on dying and death and cultivate a spiritual practice of being comfortable with their own dying as well as those they care for.
