This dynamic course explores the intersection of occupational therapy and music therapy by examining the principles of sensory processing, executive functioning, and neurorehabilitation. Participants will delve into the fundamental concepts and principles associated with each domain, gaining a comprehensive understanding of their applications in music therapy practice. Using an interdisciplinary lens, participants will gain knowledge and skills necessary to address sensory processing challenges, enhance executive functioning, and incorporate neurorehabilitation strategies within a music therapy context. This course promotes interdisciplinary collaboration and empowers participants to provide effective and holistic interventions that optimize client outcomes across the lifespan. No pre-requisites are required to take this course.
